**1. Health**

The genocide committed between 1975 and 1979 by the regime of Communist Party Khmer in Cambodia has left deep traces in the society, among which major psychological suffering.

Louvain Développement works together with local NGOs and the Cambodian government in the field (in Phnom Penh and the province of Kompong Speu) to improve their collaboration and to establish quality mental health care in a vision of complementarity and coordination of actions.



**Key results for 2007**

- ✓ An observation unit and a hospitalisation unit were created and now exist at both municipal and national level;
- ✓ The information on patients is computerised rules are applied regarding admission, treatment and discharge of patients as well as the consent of patients and families;
- ✓ Clinical supervision is conducted in the presence of an expatriate psychiatrist to increase the exchange between mental health professionals and improve the knowledge of caregivers;
- ✓ The project is extended to other provinces and psychosocial skills have improved;
